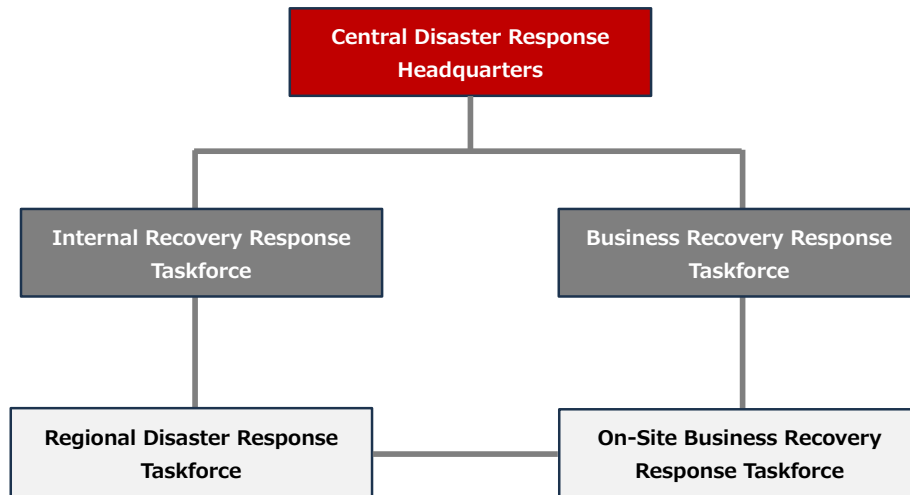


Group-wide disaster management

Group-wide disaster management system



Fujitsu Group joint disaster response drills

Fujitsu and its group companies in Japan conduct an annual nationwide disaster drill incorporating mock disaster exercises. The purpose of this drill is to assess the impacts of disasters and how those impacts apply to customers and the Group by simulating highly probable large-scale earthquakes or volcanic eruptions that are very likely to cause serious damage. A company-wide disaster management system has been created to collaboratively gain proficiency in and verify the procedures for dealing with large-scale disasters such as a “Tokyo Metropolitan Area Earthquake”, “Nankai Trough Megaquake” or “Eruption of Mt Fuji”.

During the actual drills, business sites—including any affected facilities—work together to check the initial response procedures and business continuity measures undertaken, as well as the steps taken to support the recovery of customers' ICT systems. At the same time, facilities throughout Japan verify the initial response procedures by the Regional Disaster Response Taskforce immediately following a disaster, including checking on employee safety and assessing facility damage. Through these drills, issues are identified and reviewed so that we can work to enhance the organization's disaster preparedness and business continuity capabilities.

Inspection work carried out by specialist teams

Inspection work is conducted at selected facilities across Fujitsu and its Group companies in Japan, specifically those deemed most at risk and most likely to be impacted by any damage. Led in the field by specialist teams drawn from internal departments for risk management (fire prevention and disaster preparedness), these

inspections check on legal compliance and provide inspections and guidance to prevent accidents as a result of fires and other natural disasters and from deterioration in aging infrastructure.

Case studies illustrating the improvements and the most successful disaster preparedness measures resulting from these inspections are also shared to help promote stable and safe operations throughout Fujitsu and its Group companies in Japan.
